Port Authority architects work on a wide range of projects within the general context of transportation and infrastructure. Whether working on a major public project such as an airport terminal rehabilitation, or a support structure such as a firefighting facility, the in-house architectural team is committed to quality and efficiency to serve the design needs of the agency. The architectural unit is part of a multi-discipline group of engineers and other design professionals that form the Engineering Department of the agency.

In this position, you will work under the supervision of a Principal Architect. Responsibilities include planning (Pre-Stage I); preliminary design (Stage I); design development (Stage II); contract documents (Stage III); reviewing shop drawings; revising post award designs (Stage IV); reviewing building codes; cost estimating; supervising and producing design tasks related to architectural deliverables; coordinating with supervisors, other team members, and other engineering disciplines as well as interfacing with consultants.

- Bachelor's Degree from an architectural program accredited by the National Architectural Accrediting Boards (NAAB). A Master's degree is highly desirable.
- 4-8 years of experience in all phases of design, code analysis, estimating, and field inspection
- An architectural license in either New York or New Jersey is highly desirable

- Knowledge of MS Word, Excel and the AutoCAD Architectural
